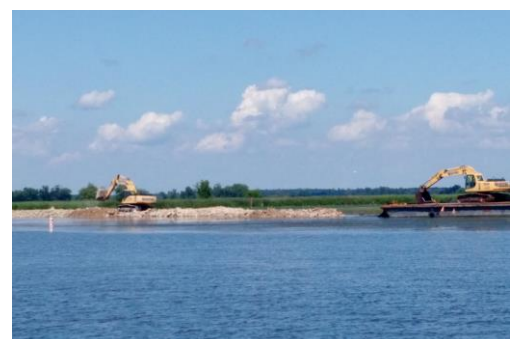

SPEAKER AT OUR SEPTEMBER MEETING

Captain Greg Karch of **Learn 2 Fish With Us** will be at our Meeting September 3rd. Greg started Learn 2 Fish in 2006 because of his passion for getting kids and adults involved in fishing. The mission of the non-profit 501c3 is to "Grow the sport of fishing by educating and inspiring beginning and experienced anglers". Since 2006 Greg has put on 250 events and in 2019 Learn 2 Fish will have hosted 35 events contacting 6,000 youth and 3,000 adults and parents. At our meeting Greg will explain the different types of clinics he hosts and the importance of volunteers and how partnering with LPSC can benefit kids and both organizations. We look forward to seeing Greg on September 3rd at 7:00 pm at the Viking.

PROJECT UPDATE

Poygan Breakwall: DNR is reviewing the maintenance agreement for the breakwall and we are soliciting bids and



construction should be completed yet in 2019. This is roughly a \$1,000,000 project and the Club is putting \$150,000 toward it. It should get us about 2.5 times the length of the present Phase I structure depending on costs.

Woody Habitat: We are exploring the next locations for woody habitat between Orihula and Lake Poygan on the Wolf River. We hope to identify a dozen sites and anchor trees to provide habitat mainly for crappie, bluegill, and catfish.
