## **PROJECT UPDATES**

**Poygan Breakwall:** The Phase II of the Poygan Breakwall is in full swing and scheduled to be completed by ice over. We are already seeing great impact from Phase I with increased wild celery growth in the backwater areas. There will be a three-year waiting period from this phase to the next to observe the integrity of the structure. All boating and snowmobile clubs have been made aware of the project and a copy of the permit has been sent to each of them.

**In-lake Fish Reefs and Woody Habitat:** We're working with the DNR and Fox-Wolf Watershed Alliance to get more of these projects located and funded. We will likely place another reef or two near the others in the water north of Spruce Landing. More to follow.
