TWO MORE FISH REEFS INSTALLED

We got the DNR and Army Corps permits just in time to get the 2nd and 3rd walleye reefs completed. The two new structures are in the area of the one installed last year at coordinates 44 degrees 08.483' and 88 degrees 49.041'. Thanks go out especially to Pat Gorshals for staying on top of the permit process - if the permit would have been delayed another few days, the project would have cost a lot more to barge out in the open water.



POYGAN BREAKWALL PERMITTING CONTINUES

We are continuing to address permit concerns for the Poygan Breakwall. This structure is key in guiding the Wolf River water back along its previous course instead of plowing through arguably one of the best water celery / wetland complexes on Winnebago System. The DNR will be out reviewing the site on April 8th. We are hoping to have Kendall Kamke of the DNR at our May 5th meeting to give an update on this important project.

PROJECT UPDATES

West Bay Cane Beds: We will continue to work with Andrew Sabaia and Club volunteers to rid the West Bay Canes of invasives and enhance this rapidly declining habitat.

Poygan Breakwall: We have a permit pending with DNR. Funding is in place for the first 1000+ feet of the structure. This one will show that this is a viable strategy for the rest of the wall.

Fish Sticks: Our permit has expired on anchored woody habitat, but we may go after more sites in the future.

Fish Reefs: Completed. The three reefs are located just about straight north of the Spruce Landing of County Road B. We have a total of 9 locations spotted and other are to come.
