



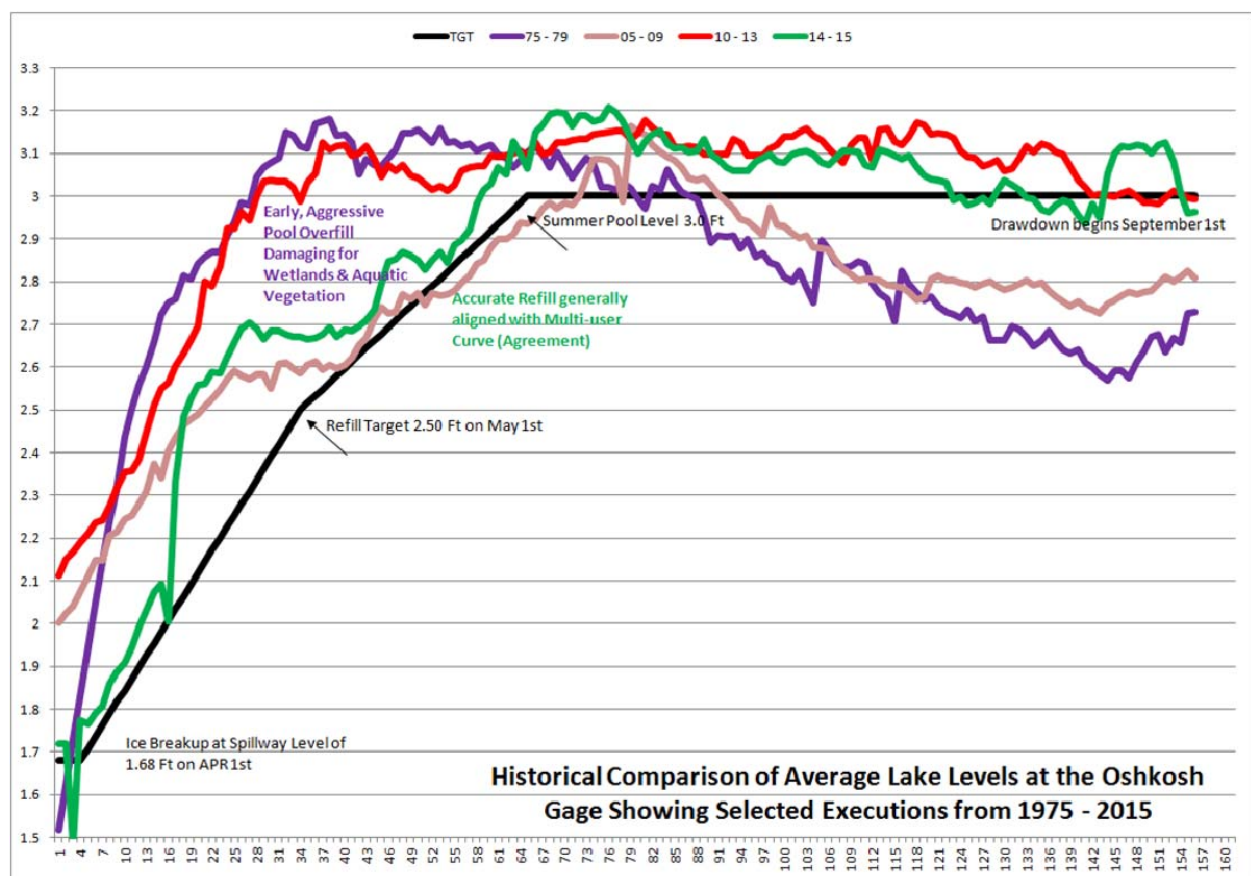

## TOM BETT PRESENTATION SUMMARY

Our thanks to Tom Bett who put together a great presentation on the importance of water level management in the Winnebago System with regard to beneficial aquatic plants. One of the most telling graphs from his presentation is shown below and indicates how Spring water levels from '75 - '79 and '10 - '13 missed the Spring target (by a lot on the high side) and how '05 - '09 and '14 - '15 were very close to the target.

The Spring refill period is the time that is most critical for the formation of good beds of beneficial aquatic plants. All of us looking out at the lake these past 2 years sure have seen the difference. He certainly had a lot of other great information, but this was a great take away.
