PROJECT UPDATES

Reef Coordinates: The much coveted coordinates for our newly installed walleye reef are: 88 degrees 48.106' and 44 degrees 8.585'. Because we receive public funds for this project, the numbers are public information. The reef was 25' by 100' and all below 6 feet of summer water depth.

West Bay Canes: Art Techlow is working with the DNR Endangered Resources staff and the NRDA folks to figure out what to do for the Forster's Terns at the West Bay canes. And what's good for the terns is typically good for the canes.

Breakwall: In July the DNR will be doing a mussel survey for the first phase of the Lake Poygan breakwall. This is part of the requirements for the DNR permit. Art is also working on other aspects of permit application requirements for the Corps of Engineers.
