PROJECT UPDATE

West Bay Cane Beds: The canes really took a beating this past year. Tern nesting was way down this Spring. We are working with Andrew Sabai and Club volunteers to rid the West Bay Cane Bed of invasive species (Cattails and non-native Phragmites) and assess any new growth from last year's plantings. Any hard armoring is on hold at this point.

Poygan Breakwall: We have a permit from the DNR and are up for approval at the state's building meeting in June. We also need the Army Corps of Engineers (ACE) OK for this work which we should have soon - we are trying to get the ACE permit by the time the building meeting takes place. We did miss out on funding from the NAWCAW grant program (\$75,000), but that won't hold us back at this point.

In-lake Fish Reefs: There are now 3 fish reefs complete in the area of the one placed last year. We are still shooting for more - stay tuned.

Banquet: We had 24 less attendees at the banquet but had one of our best year yet with over \$12,000 being raised for Lake Poygan habitat! Thanks to all who attended and especially to Tom Wilson and Pat Gorchals and his great crew of volunteers!!
